➤ **Summer Events**

Family Picnic... 122 attended... all 144 hot dogs were gone and the kids enjoyed the games.

NEW Swimming Lessons... 26 registered... Perfect day one... then, lessons had to be cancelled due to 2 days of heavy rain & high winds. Also the swim instructor, injured herself & was not able to fulfil her duties. The ISA has an alternate instructor, however she also injured herself & was not available. Lessons rescheduled for Aug 5/6/7 & 13 attended. The participants completed enough hours of lessons to earn a Red Cross level badge.

Pancake Breakfast... 154 attended... Sold out of Pancakes! This event has been a true enjoyment for many LSH residents. The success of this event comes from the pride the volunteers bring to the table of this event.

Horseshoe Tournament ... 40 took part & 50 in the gallery to cheer on the participants.

➤ **Community Improvements**

At the end of June, the main beach had rock cleanup work done. The scope of the work included, 100 feet of fist sized rocks were scraped and put up along the bank, 2 loads of boulders were brought in and positioned up along the bank to stabilized that bank. At the end of August, the replacement of 3 new park benches was done. The cost of the beach cleanup \$2835 & benches \$2000... Half of which will be paid by the Province of Manitoba CPP grant that LSHA received. Also the Basketball backboard & hoop was replace...for a cost of \$20 Thanks to Edith's Yard Sale Find!

In July the RM installed **retro reflective civic address signs** on all properties in LSH & positioned for 911 visibility. Any property that purchased an **approved sign**, as per the RM instruction from years ago, will have a \$25 Tax CR applied to their Tax bill.
