

UPDATE on Ditches and Roads



The RM of St.Clements Beaconia Public works first came into LSH to trench a back ditch system, running the length of the back of properties along North Drive & Bayview from Northshore Road to Road 102. This was first done in May of 1995 and in Dec 2002 the RM re-dug the back ditches.

This year on August 8-2016, the RM came to start a much needed back ditch project. The RM has recently purchased a mini excavator which is the ideal piece of equipment required to do this type of work. The crew first brushed out the entire length of the ditch using a brush cutter on the mini excavator. Will remove larger trees that are within the parameters of the ditch. Once the ditch has been prepared, they will survey then grade the ditch accordingly.

Ongoing communications with the RM of St. Clements and Province of MB Infrastructure, identifying concerns regarding road conditions and maintenance of gravel roads on PR 500 from Beaconia to Highway 12, as well as Municipal Mile Roads 100, 101 and 102. And specifically in the maintenance of the Seasonal gravel roads, drainage and ditches in the area of LakeShoreHeights. Larger volumes of water are flowing in new patterns, which has brought observations and questions. This is being looked into by the New Director of Public Works.

In 2014, the Manitoba Minister of Infrastructure and Transportation acknowledged the problems the PR 500, and committed the Province to work with the Major of St. Clements to address poor drainage and surface conditions.

In the Selkirk Journal, March 30/2016 edition, Mayor Debbie Fiebelkorn of the RM St. Clements, had spoken of "improved roads".... Full article can be found on line with the Selkirk Journal website.

In June 2016 an inquiry to the Province was made regarding the road conditions on PR 500. The response; Weather & Ground conditions have been very wet over the past several years, with 2016 being hard on gravel roads. The road appears to have stabilized for the time being due to the maintenance. The Province has confirmed discussions with the RM of St Clements about the issue of road maintenance and drainage. However, there is no capital work currently approved for PR 500 at this time.
