www.trailsmanitoba.ca Boarder to Beaches, Red River North Section of the Trans Canada Trail is right here in LSH. Between Roads 101 & 102 along West Street. It is designated as a Walking / Hiking / Cycling section of the trail. The Trans Canada Trail does not support ATV use as one of the many activities. The Red River North Trail Association (RRNTA) came together to develop a section of the Trans Canada Trail and is over 225 kilometres in length. Stretching from the northeast outskirts of Winnipeg to Grand Beach / Grand Marais, to Powerview-Pine Falls, ending at the Great Falls Dam. The trail includes the R.M.'s of East St. Paul, Springfield, St. Andrews, St. Clements, Brokenhead, Alexander, and including the City of Selkirk.

Last fall, parents of responsible riders came forward in regards to respectful children taking note of the regulations. We thank those who bring forward concerns and are being proactive and their willingness to deal with any issues caused by unsafe riding of ORV/ATV's in LSH. As a Friendly Reminder... it is the owner/operators



responsibility to know and understand the Highway Traffic Act and the rules of the road. The rules do not have to be posted to be enforceable. **The Off-Road Vehicles Act - Manitoba Laws** Oct 1, 1988 - 26(1) No person under the age of **14 years** shall operate an off-road vehicle unless supervised and accompanied by, and at all times within clear view of the person's parent, or a person who has attained the age of **18 years** and authorized by the parent. **What else should I know**

about operating my ORV safely? Off Road Vehicles – as indicated by Manitoba Public Insurance www.mpi.mb.ca Operating rules fall into these categories: riders' age, helmets, towing, and where you can and can't ride.

Did you know there is an ATV club in the East Beaches area? This non profit organization formed to support and promotes the sport in the region so that ATV enthusiasts can enjoy the beauty of area trails. If you SEE a bear in your path... Stop and remain calm. Get ready to use your bear spray. Do not run away.



There have been sightings of Bears in LSH over the past few weeks. "We live in their backyard." Carry bear spray with you at all times on the trail, know how to use it. Bears hear & smell for food...they go for easy food first. Keep your yard clean of garbage, including recycling bins, don't leave pet food outside, and take down bird feeders... **Never Feed Bears.**

There are **Three types of bear behaviors to be aware of...**

- 1) nuisance ... bear is just passing through an area
- 2) property damage... bear shows defensive behavior & runs off
- 3) potential danger to humans... at this point Conservation should be contacted to proactively set trap
